## Progressive Features

$\checkmark$ Provides a refundable earned income tax credit (EITC)
$\checkmark$ Provides a refundable tax credit to reduce the impact of its sales tax on groceries

## Regressive Features

$\boldsymbol{X}$ Fails to index income tax brackets to inflation
$X$ Sales tax base includes groceries
$\boldsymbol{X}$ Comparatively high combined state and local sales tax rate

## Recent Developments

- Lowered top personal income tax rate to 5.25 percent
